We want to provide students who want to play basketball with a positive basketball experience. *Positively Hoops* will work closely with the High School coaches and student-athletes to provide opportunities for our youth to learn the fundamentals of basketball and further enhance their basketball skills. Register NOW and become part of the *Positively Hoops* team.

The 3-8th grade boys and girls will play tournament basketball their entire season. Players will be asked to tryout, so they can be placed onto a team that matches their ability. All players from both public and private schools must tryout at the scheduled tryout dates in the fall. All tryouts are at the **high school**. **Girls** will tryout on Saturday, October 3rd from 1:00-2:30 and on Sunday, October 4th from 3:30-5:00. **Boys** will tryout on Saturday, October 3rd from 2:30-4:00 and Sunday, October 4th from 5:00-6:30.
